FREE Tax Preparation

Earn MORE.

You'll be amazed at how much you can get back at tax time by claiming the federal and Iowa Earned Income Credit (EIC). For example, the maximum federal tax credit for a single worker with two children whose income is less than \$43,038 is \$5,372! Plus, you can get even more back from the Iowa EIC!

Keep MORE.

Why pay someone to prepare your taxes when you can go to a free Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) site (see box at right) in your community? Or, you can do your taxes yourself with My Free Taxes, a free on-line tax preparation service. Go to <http://myfreetaxes.com> for more information on free tax preparation resources. When you use these free services, you get your money back within 10 -14 days!

Save MORE.

There are opportunities to help you save more of the money — at tax time and throughout the year! With SaveYourRefund (www.saveyourrefund.com), you can use Form 8888 to save a part of your refund, right when you file - and enter to win weekly cash prizes! Some local organizations that sponsor the free VITA sites also hold workshops to help with saving and planning for your financial future. Ask your tax advisor at your local VITA site for details about these programs.
